To all Seneca View Residents and Families:

We are contacting you today to let you know that we have had one resident and an additional direct care staff member test positive for COVID-19. The resident's family has been notified and the staff member has been removed from the schedule for the required quarantine period. The facility remains on full precautions and twice weekly testing will continue for all residents and staff. At this time we have one resident on isolation precautions and eight staff off for quarantine.

With growing numbers of active COVID-19 cases in our community, additional personal protective equipment (PPE) will be required for visits. The care team will be able to assist you with this upon your arrival. We ask that you inform our nursing units of your planned visit so we can properly assist your loved ones for your visit and answer any questions you may have about the PPE needed. Entrance screening of all guests continues, including a non-contact temperature reading and a few risk evaluation questions, as required by the Department of Health. Social distancing and infection prevention practices must still be maintained for all visitors to the nursing home and we ask that you postpone your visit if you are exhibiting any symptoms of illness.
