To all Seneca View Residents and Families:

We are contacting you today to let you know that we have had one direct care staff member and two residents test positive for COVID-19. These positive cases were identified during our weekly testing and the families have been notified. The staff member has been removed from the schedule for the required quarantine period. These positive cases have been isolated to one nursing unit and the facility has returned to full precautions until we can determine the extent of any outbreak underway. Twice weekly testing will continue for all residents and staff.

We are again required to limit general restricted visitation, however, visitation accommodations can be made under the compassionate care visitation program. End-of-life visitation will not be interrupted. Please contact your respective nursing units to schedule any visits and to learn of any additional infection prevention measures required for your visit. Social distancing and infection prevention practices must still be maintained for all visitors to the nursing home. If you have concerns regarding visitation please contact the Nursing Units, Nursing Administration, or my office.
