**To all Seneca View Residents and Families:**

Please be advised that we have had a resident test positive for COVID-19. The resident's family has been notified and additional infection prevention measures have been put in place. No additional cases have been identified among staff as we have continued twice weekly testing. At this time we have a total of two staff off for quarantine and three residents on isolation for having tested positive, including the one we are informing you of today. Two of these residents will be coming off precautions tomorrow.

We are required to continue under the existing restricted visitation guidelines at this time although end-of-life visitation will not be interrupted. For residents experiencing difficulty with reduced visitation, accommodations can be made under the compassionate care visitation program. Please contact your respective nursing units to discuss this option and for the scheduling of any visits. Additional infection prevention measures may be required for your visit. Social distancing and infection prevention practices must still be maintained for all visitors to the nursing home. If you have concerns regarding visitation please contact the Nursing Units, Nursing Administration, or my office.
