

Seneca View Restricted Visitation Program Details

Information to review with families when scheduling a visit:

Important: Residents that are on 14 day observation/quarantine cannot have visitors. Residents suspect for COVID/ill cannot have visitors.

- Upon entering at our screening location they will:
 - Be screened in
 - Asked if they are willing to be tested – this is a nasal swab – it does not go far up into the nostril and takes 15 minutes to get results. Once we have the results they will be escorted to and from the visit site – currently the dining room on the resident unit.
 - If they have been tested elsewhere we ask that it meet our guidelines of within 72 hours of the visit.
 - They must wear a surgical mask and we will provide this
 - They must perform hand hygiene before entering the SNF

- Social Distancing is still required – they need to know they will be required to maintain 6 feet from the resident and if two visitors are present from each other as well.
- When scheduling the visit – complete the required information from the visitor – name, address, phone, and email if applicable.
- At this time visits are scheduled Monday through Friday at 10:30am to 11:30am, 2:00 to 2:30pm and 3:00 to 3:30pm. –
- Visits are limited to 30 minutes at one time.

Restricted Visitation Guidelines

- Visits are limited to 30 minutes

- I must mask and wear mask appropriately over nose and mouth at all times.
- I will wash my hands before visit – hand sanitizer to be used
- I understand I will be escorted to designated visitor areas and out.
- I will immediately notify Seneca View if I become ill or test positive for COVID.

POLICY STATEMENT: It is the policy of Seneca View Skilled Nursing to provide safe visitation to our residents, families and staff following NYSDOH guidelines for Restricted Visitation

1. PROCEDURE:

2. Screening:

- a. All visitors will be screened upon entering the building to determine ability to enter the skilled nursing facility.
- b. Visitors are provided hand hygiene supplies in accordance with regulations and asked to conduct hand hygiene before entering the facility.
- c. A fact sheet will be provided at this time outlining visitor expectations.
 - i. Use of Hand Hygiene
 - ii. Masking requirements
 - iii. Distancing requirements
 - iv. Going directly to designated visit site.
- d. Contact information will be obtained for each visitor:
 - i. First and Last Name of Visitor
 - ii. Physical street address
 - iii. Daytime and Evening Phone Number
 - iv. Date and Time of Visit and
 - v. Email address if applicable.

3. All Visitors will be offered to be tested following the Rapid Antigen Protocols. It is not mandatory for visitors to test, but is highly recommended.

4. Once visitor is approved to enter

- a. Must have a surgical mask in place.
- b. Is escorted to and from the designated visit area.
- c. Visit is supervised, allowing for privacy while assuring compliance with infection control practices.
- d. Will be escorted back out of facility upon completion of the visit.

5. **Environmental Cleaning**
 - a. **The table and chair used by both resident and visitor will be cleaned with the designated disinfectant and the appropriate kill time will be met.**
 - b. **If the visit was required/appropriate to be in the resident room, any and all items noted to have been touched during the visit will be disinfected, and Visitors are instructed to not touch items in the room to limit contact concerns.**
 - c. **Any and all clear protective dividers that are in use will be appropriately disinfected between each visit.**

6. **Visitation is not allowed as indicated below:**
 - a. **Facility has a COVID Positive resident and/or employee in past 14 days**
 - b. **If resident have visible signs of COVID/under investigation for COVID and residents on 14 day quarantine or observation.**
 - c. **County positivity rates is greater than 10% - (visitation must occur only for compassionate care situations)**

7. **Other Infection Control Practices:**
 - a. **The number of visitors per resident is limited to 2 at one time**
 - b. **The number of visitors in the entire facility at one time is limited to 20% of our current census.**
 - c. **Visits will be scheduled in advance and limited to 30 minutes.**
 - d. **Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.**
 - e. **Indoor visits will be conducted in the Dining Rooms as is applicable to resident situation and only 2 residents with max of two visitors each will be in this space to allow for proper 6 feet distancing. Floor markings as applicable will be in place.**
 - f. **When weather permits visits will be held outdoors using covered tents and our unit 3 deck for that unit only, and unit 1 gazebo for that unit only**
 - g. **Adequate staff and PPE to meet the criteria for this visitation plan must be met**
 - h. **Appropriate signage will be in place for masking, hand hygiene and floor markings.**
